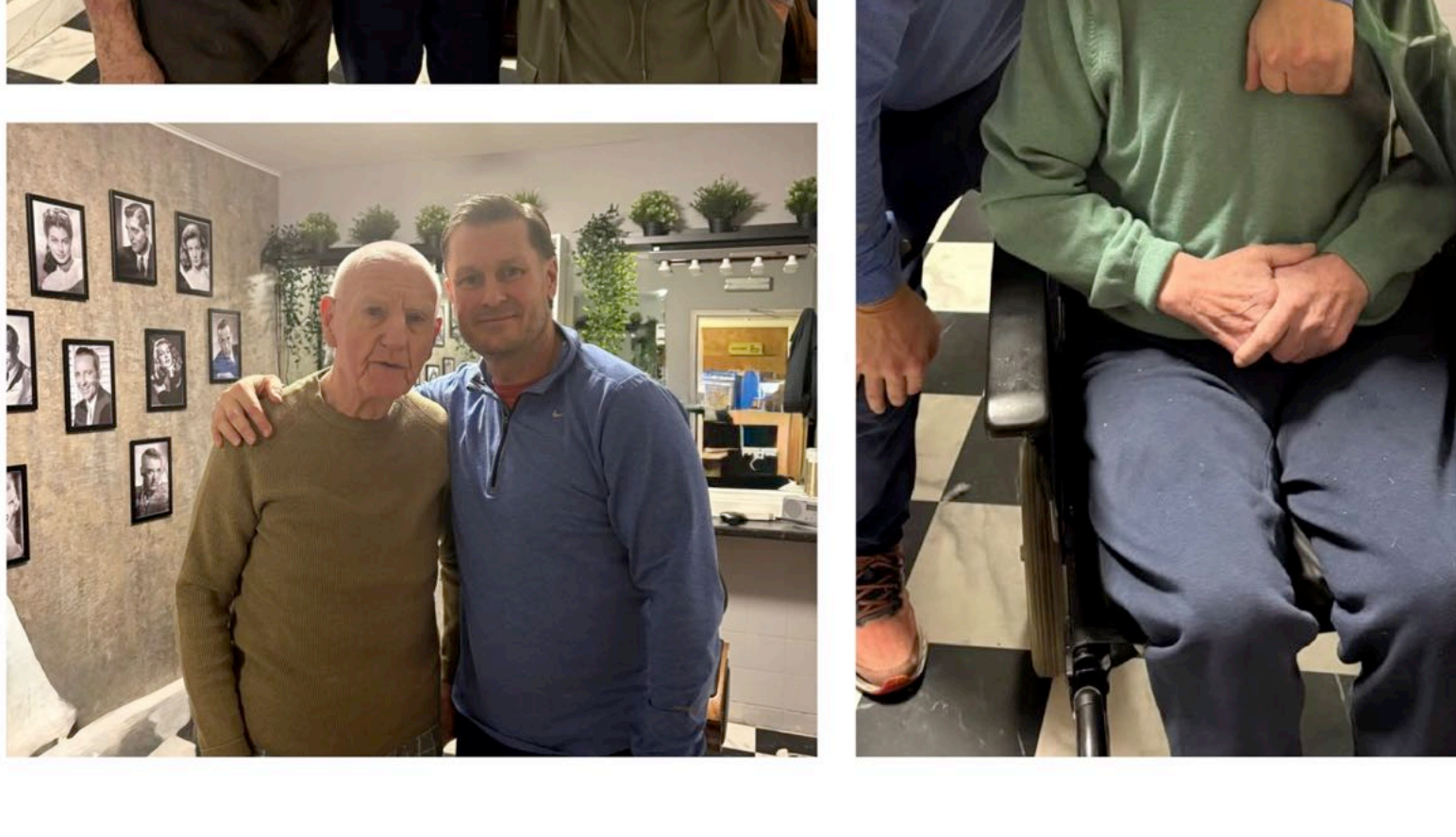

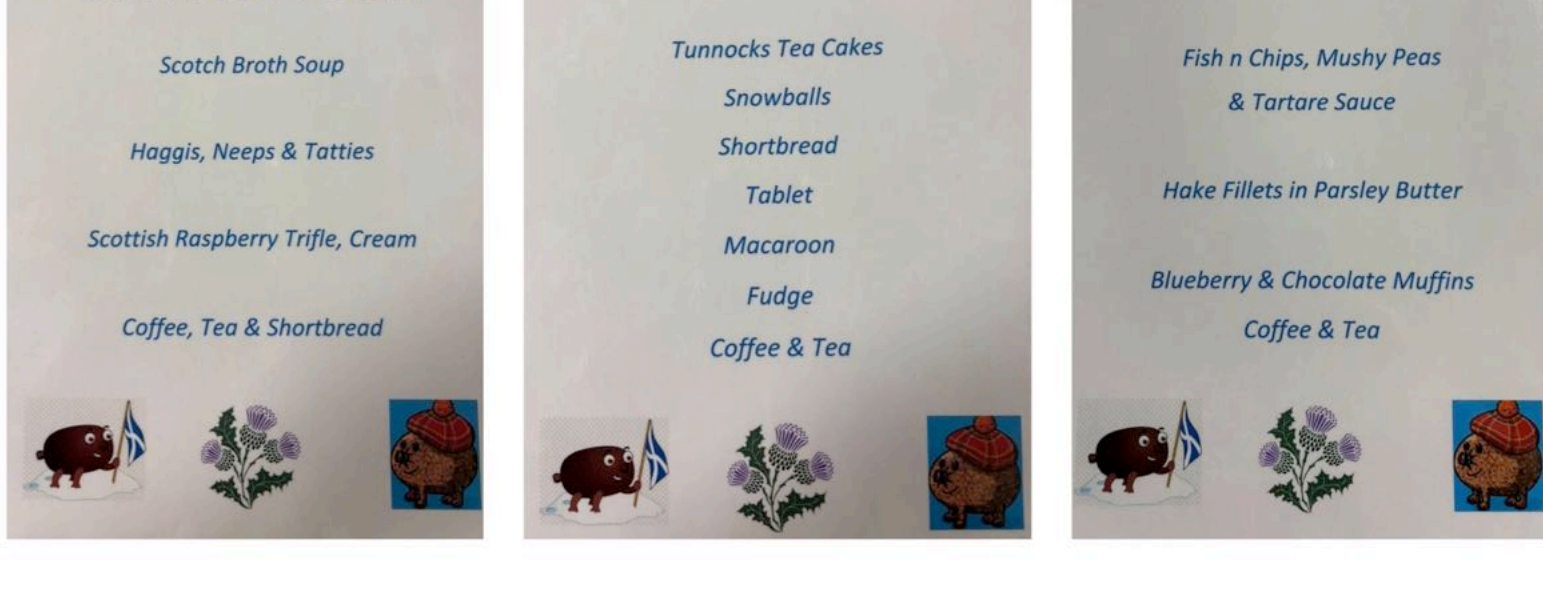
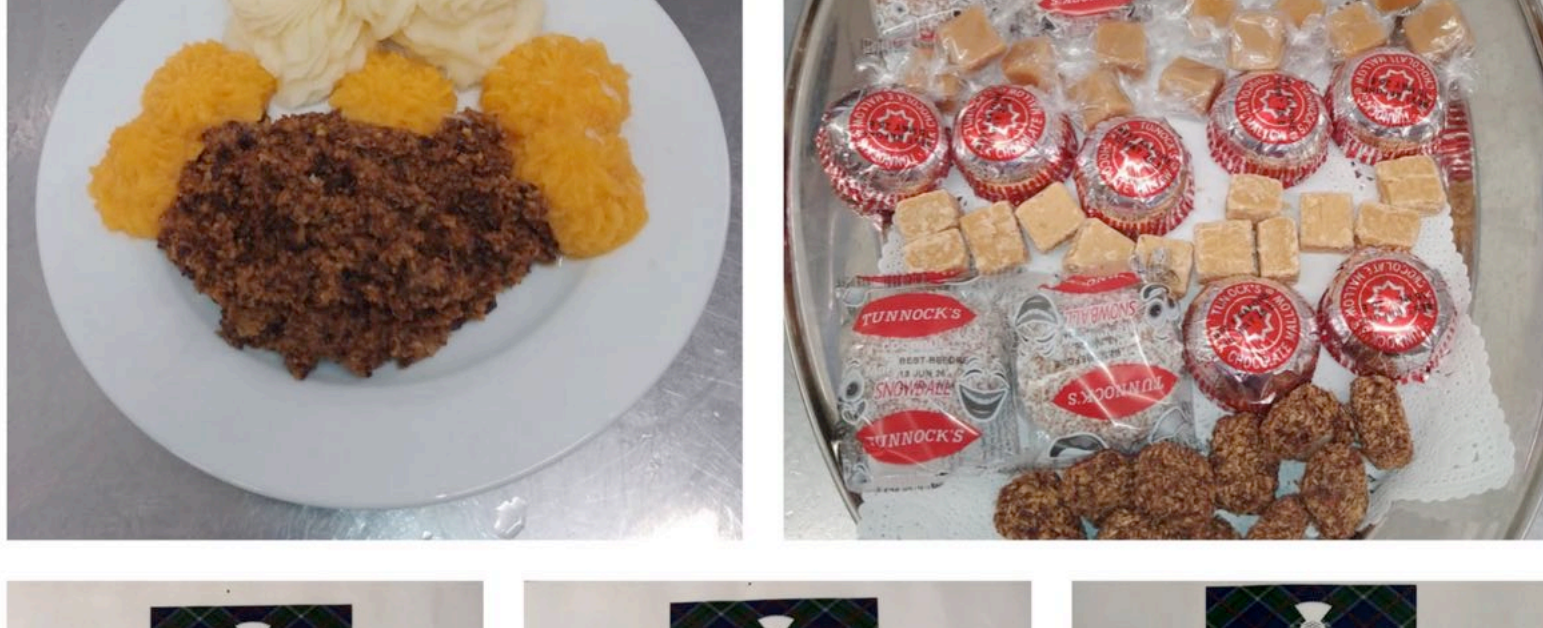
Kevin the Caring Barber

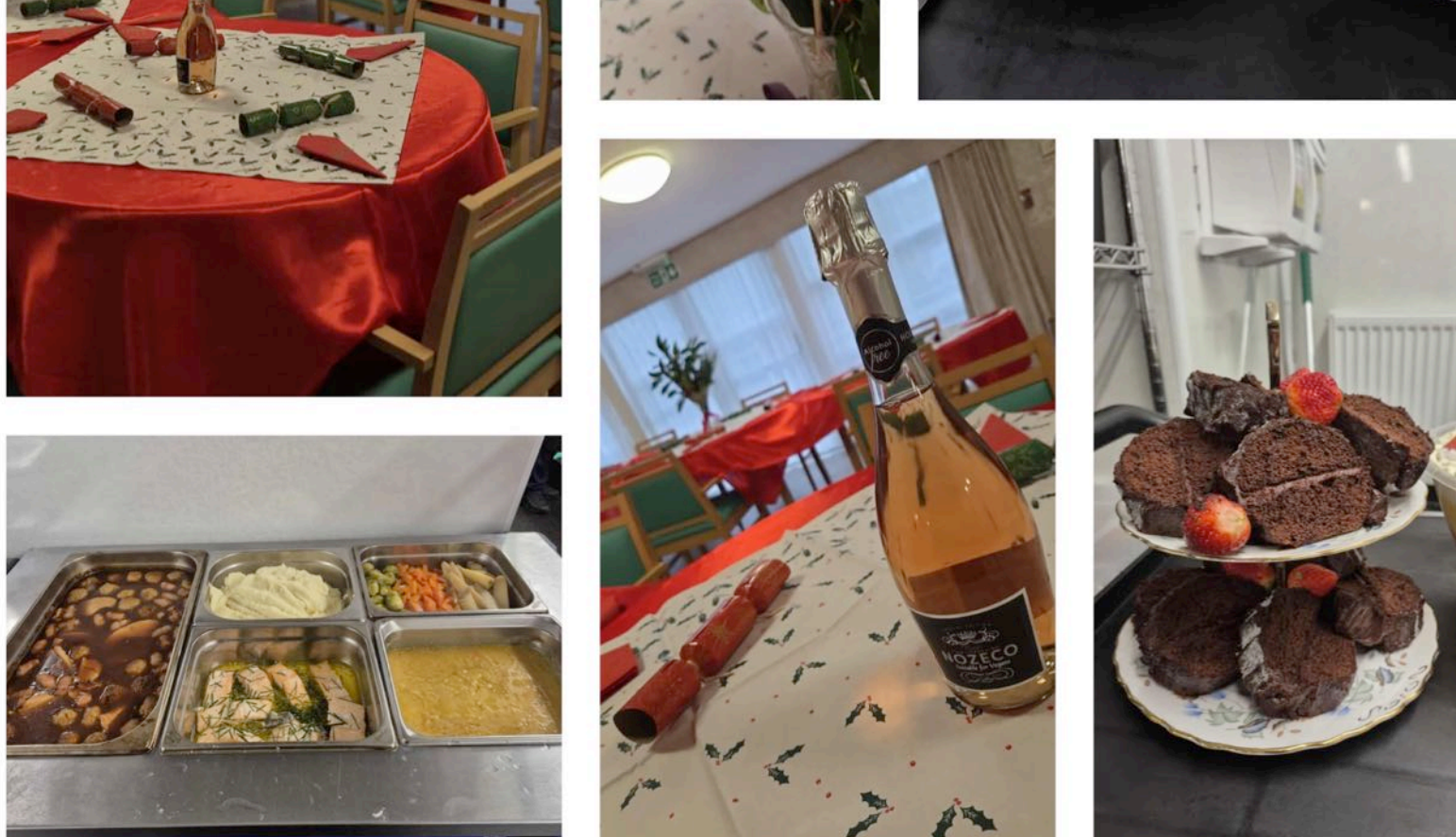
Burns Day Celebrations

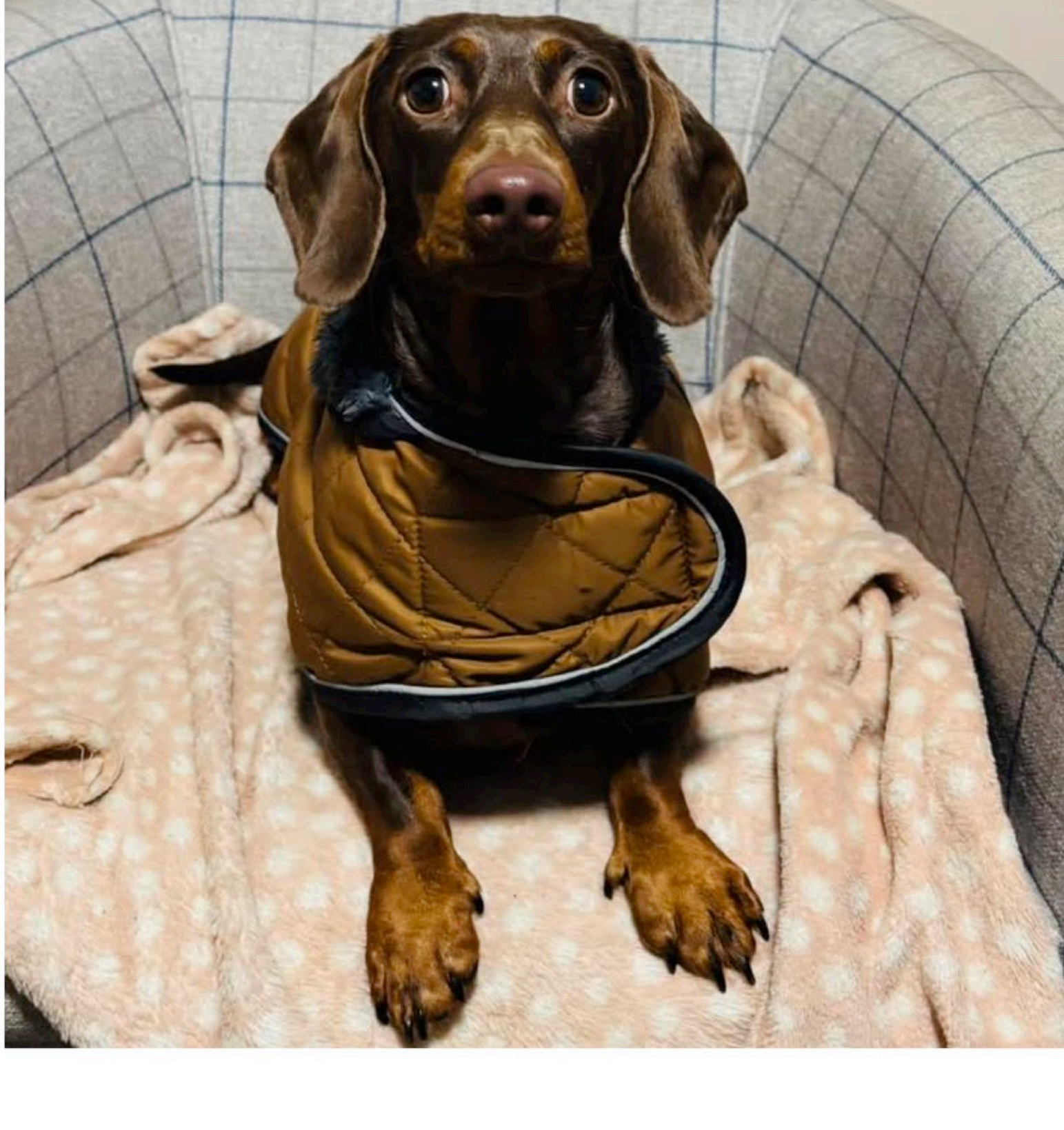
St Andrew's Day
